

Explosion Box – Wedding Gift paodesign.at – Patricia Outland – Austria



- DSP "Fancy Frost" 12" x12"
- Thick Whisper White Cardstock
- Silver Foil Sheet
- Dazzling Diamond Glimmer Paper
- "So in Love" Clearmount Bundle
- "Timeless Textures" Stampset
- Stiched Framelits
- Bow Builder Punch
- Silver Emboss Powder & Stuff





Form the basic exploding box from a 12" paper by scoring each side at 4".

Cut 2 slits on the opposite sites from the top to the middle along the score lines.

Cut the corners of like in this picture (This is not my picture!)

Then glue along the bottom line the cut flaps and form 2 pockets on each opposites.

And then decorate... as you whish 🎔

The lid:



Score a 6 x 6" paper at (almost) 1" – a little less then 1" – then you have a bit of a spacing inbetween the lid and the box. Then form the lid as usual.

I decorated the lid with the belly band of the "So in love Bundle". Then I heat embossed one of the sentences in silver on it. Scored the ends and fixed it with Tombow on the lid.

To finish it of, i used the silver ribbon – i glued it tight with fast fuse. A silver metall foil – punched out with the "Bow Builder Punch" is hiding the joint.



The flaps left and right are simply decorated with silver metall foil cutouts. The text i have printed on whisper white. Decoration is from "Timeless Textures" – heat embossed with silver embossing powder.

In the upper pouch I've put a greeting card. The bottom pouch has a folded up cardstock that contains a poem of Khalis Gibran. A heat embossed flower from the "So in Love Bundle" catches the eye a bit. ©

The basket:



I die-cut 2 pieces of the framelits from the "So in Love Bundle".



Then I scored them in the middle and glued them into the little box I made.

The measurements are: 9 x 9 cm (3,54") Scored by 1 cm (7/16 of an inch).

Then simply folded the pieces in half and glued them to the rim of the box.

To finish the bottom off nicely, i cut out a square piece of the Dazzling Diamond Glimmer Paper – a bit smaller then the 7 x 7 cm bottom. I put the basket on a podest of silver metall foil.
